### REPUBLIC OR DEMOCRACY?

"For too long a period," complains a reader, "Americans have become entirely too careless in the use of political terms. Statesmen, politicians, lecturers, common people, even edicators, have been lauding and defending our 'democracy.'

"We are not a 'democracy'. We were organized as a republic' and that is still our form of government. It used to be so taught in the public schools, and should be so taught

So an old argument is renewed. It is complicated because one of our big political parties is "Republican" and the other "Democratic," so that partisan prejudices often get into the

Historically there were real distinctions between the two terms. But in America, particularly in this century, it be-

The new Century Dictionary defines "democracy" as "goy ernment by the people; a form of government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them or their elected agents."

It defines "republic" as "a state in which the suprem

power rests in the body of citizens entitled to vote and is exercised by representatives chosen directly or indirectly by

To a man from Mars there wouldn't seem to be much 10 a man from Mars there wouldn't seem to be much difference between these two concepts. The original "democracies" were Greek city-states where all the citizens voted directly for public officials and measures. Perhaps the only cracy" we have today in this country is a New

For democracy we have today in this country is a New England town meeting which follows the same procedure.

It is necessary, as citizens become more numerous, to de-gate more and more of the popular authority, voting for officials who in turn execute, legislate, judge, and appoint other officials. With our growing ease of communication and our direct influence over statesmen and lawmakers, this dele gated authority itself becomes more direct and therefor ore democratic. Thus, though acting more through "agents", we are perhaps more truly a democracy today than we were in George Washington's time.


